Irving Spring Tune-up Tournament

- WHEN:** February 26-28, 2010 Irving teams may be required to play on Friday February 26. Other teams may Request a Friday game.
- AGE GROUPS:** **RECREATIONAL TEAMS** Boys and Girls, ages Under 6 through Under 19. 3 Guest Players U10 – U19, no Guest Players U6-U8. U-6 play 5-per-side. U-8 play 7-per-side. U-10 play 8-per-side. Proof of age must be available upon request at each game. We will have U-9 , U-11 and U-13 divisions if a minimum of six teams qualify for these age groups.
COMPETITIVE DIVISION TEAMS Under 11-19, 5 guest players. Medical releases must be noteried.
ACADEMY DIVISION TEAMS Under 10, No guest players.
- FEE:** **Recreational:** U-6 \$100 per team. U-8 \$125 per team. U-10 \$225 per team. U-12 \$250 per team. U-14 \$275 per team. 16/19 \$300 per team. Fifty dollars non-refundable.
Competitive Teams: U12 U19 \$ 400 per team. Fifty dollars non-refundable.
Academy Teams: U10 \$ 375 per team. Fifty dollars non-refundable.
- If any team withdraws after being accepted by the tournament, that team's entry fee is forfeited to the tournament.
- AWARDS:** Individual participation awards will be given to all U-6 and U-8 participants. In all other age divisions, individual awards will be given to all first and second place teams.
- FORMAT:** Each team will play 3 mini-games Saturday with flight winners advancing to bracket competition. U-6 and U-8 will play 3 games on Saturday; no standings will be kept.
- SCORING:** In mini-games, a team will receive 6 points for a win, 3 points for a tie, 0 points for a loss or forfeit. Each goal is worth 1 point, up to a maximum of 3 points per game. 1 point will be given for a shut out. In bracket games, a winner must be determined. In case of a tie, bracket will go immediately into penalty kicks. Championship and /or consolation game ends in a tie, 2 overtime periods will be played and, if necessary, then penalty kicks.
- PROTESTS:** All referee decisions will be final and protests will not be allowed. Any challenge of rosters or other questions must be brought to the attention of the field marshal or tournament director immediately, in writing with a \$100 money order or cash deposit.
- LIMIT:** No more than 120 teams will be accepted. The entry fee will be refunded to those teams not accepted.

Check-in and pick up your team packet Friday at the tournament headquarters, bring medical releases for each of your players, copy of signed roster, and Guest Player release forms signed by your Associations Registrar.
